PARENT EDUCATION NIGHTS

Education & Prevention staff will work with your school or organization to host a virtual or in-person event to include a brief TDV & Healthy Relationships presentation followed by a question and answer conversation where parents can learn and ask questions about how to best support their children to have healthy, non-violent relationships and assist them if they are experiencing TDV or unhealthy relationships.

Teen Dating Violence Statistics*

1 in 3 teens will experience an abusive relationship.



When tested, a majority of parents parents (58%) could NOT correctly identify common warning signs of abuse.



Only 35% of abused teens tell someone about it. Usually it is their closest friend.





81% percent of parents believe teen dating violence is not an issue or admit they don't know if it's ar issue.

AWARENESS PROJECT
